Please return last year's Agricultural Day Cups to the School Office ASAP

All calves attending school pet days must be: tagged with a NAIT RFID tag, and registered in the NAIT system.

Cattle must be tagged with NAIT approved RFID tags. These animals must be tagged within six months of birth, or before they move off farm - whichever is soonest. NAIT tags are the only tags required by law.

However you do not need to record animal movements to and from school pet days. For information about registering your calf and obtaining a NAIT tag visit:

Ideally the farmer you obtain the calf from will be NAIT registered and the calf will be tagged before leaving the farm.

Birth Dates: The birthdates for Ag Day lambs and calves is between 1 July and 31 August.

Registrations: Registration Forms will go out at the end of August.

Animal Booklets and Information: If you are a first time animal handler, there are booklets available from the office to guide you.
