Helpers for Ag Day:

- **Stewards:** Adults are needed to take on the role of stewards in the animal pens. Duties include: organising the animal and handler in order of appearance when judges call out place getters; help the selected children and the pets re-enter the pen for ribbon presentation; and helping children keep the animals calm. Please respond on the attached form.
 - **Runners:** This is a role that past-pupils take on. The main task is to take the judges results to the Announcers Tent. This is always very popular so it is a case of 'first-in'. If you are willing to assist please complete the attached form or contact the office.
 - **Car Park Attendants:** Required from approximately 8.00am - 9.00am to help direct vehicles. Please respond on the attached form.
- Animal Booklets and Information:** If you are a first time animal handler, there are booklets available from the office to guide you.
