**Animal Handlers:** You should be well on the way with your leading and calling. Remember to practise these activities in different places so that your pet will cope better at Agricultural Day. When you are being judged for 'Rearing', the judge wants to hear that you are the main carer. You need to be able to discuss aspects of feeding, grooming and what efforts you have gone to in preparing your pet for the big day. You may need to talk about birthdate, age and vaccinations.
