Bus Rules:

- After getting on the bus passengers to **remain seated** until the bus stops for their disembarking.
- Seat belts are to be worn, where fitted.
- Passengers to talk in **quiet, respectful voices** only.
- Passengers **remain seated at all times** with **feet in their seat area** not the aisles.
- **No eating or drinking** on the bus.
- Private items to be packed away in schoolbags. **No electronic devices** are to be used whilst on the bus.
- **Bags to be kept under the seats where possible**, aisles are to be kept clear.
- Extra items other than normal school gear to be transported on the bus at the discretion of the bus driver and with prior notice.
- When **waiting for the bus do so in an orderly manner** away from the curb.

Bus Monitors You Are Responsible For:

- Getting students lined up quickly and quietly
- Helping the staff member to get every student safely onto the bus at the end of the school day
- Making sure everyone is seated. If some have to stand, start from the oldest.
- Keeping the aisles clear of school bags and other 'luggage'
- Reporting any misbehaviour to the bus driver and the principal
- Helping students to get off the bus safely if needed
- Getting to know the names of everyone on your bus
- Remember you are there as a helper to provide assistance and ensure everyone has a safe trip
- The bus driver is in charge —you are their helper.
