On **Thursday, 11th May** children will be participating in The Great Glenbervie Basic-Fact-A-Thon. This is a fun and motivating way to encourage our children to learn basic facts for instant recall, an essential skill in the Numeracy Curriculum.

Each student will be given a list of basic facts that is appropriate to their level and are encouraged to learn/ practise these over the next weeks. The children will then be given the challenge to correctly answer as many of the equations as possible.

Children are invited to collect sponsorship for every correct answer or alternatively a donation would be welcomed. The class teacher will test the students and send the results home. The students then collect their sponsors' money and return this to school by **Wednesday 24th May**.

All money raised will go towards purchasing maths equipment, books and resources for the school.

Learning Guide:

NE/Y1- Column 1 and any more equations they can manage.

Y2- Column 1 and 2

Y3/4- Columns 1,2 and 3

Y5/6- All columns

Experts- if you consider yourself an expert ask your teacher for the 'expert list' which includes algebra, fractions, decimals and division with remainders.

The above is a guide only and children are to do what they can manage. The columns get progressively harder and children are allowed to answer equations above their level if they want to.
