Please return last year's Agricultural Day Cups to the School Office ASAP

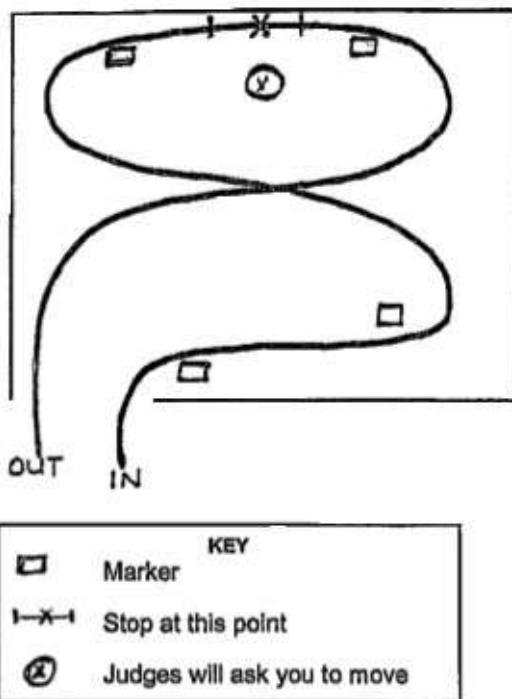
Animal Registrations: 31st August is the last day for Ag Day pet's birth date, (i.e. all pets need to be born in the months of July and August. This gives the judges a consistent age band for judging). It is now time to complete an official **Registration Form** (attached) and return to Mrs Crooks in Room 1 by 14th September. There needs to be a separate registration form for each pet.



The Day: A brief outline of the day is as follows:

The Course: Following is a diagram of the circuit used for leading in the lamb and goat pens. Try setting the circuit/course up in different places so the animal gets accustomed to change. Remember to lead the animal on the right hand side of you - the opposite to leading a dog.



Helpers for Ag Day:

- **Stewards:** Adults are needed to take on the role of stewards in the animal pens. Duties include: organising the animal and handler in order of appearance when judges call out place getters; help the selected children and the pets re-enter the pen for ribbon presentation; and helping children keep the animals calm. - **Car Park Attendants:** Required from approximately 8.00a - 9.00am to help direct vehicles. Please respond on the attached form.

The Glenberrie Fun Run and Walk in the Glenberrie Forest is back.

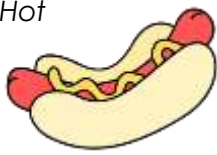
Mark Sunday, 4th November on your calendars for a family stroll or run in the forest on the 2km, 5km or 10km routes.
