Please note the following:

- Saturday is considered a school day.
- No buses run on Saturday – you need to get your children to school ready for a 9am start. All children need to have parent supervision from 11.30 onwards.
- If children have money for spending at the PTA Tent, please ensure this is in a wallet or sealed bag.
- The day begins at 9.00am for both animal and non-animal handlers.

Animal Handlers: You should be well on the way with your leading and calling. Remember to practise these activities in different places so that your pet will cope better at Agricultural Day. When you are being judged for 'Rearing', the judge wants to hear that you are the main carer. You need to be able to discuss aspects of feeding, grooming and what efforts you have gone to in preparing your pet for the big day. You may need to talk about birthdate, age and vaccinations.
