Property Update:

The planned Ministry of Education upgrade of the Office/Room 1 & 2 block is now well underway. This area is fully "wrapped" and work is expected to be completed by the end of the year. This work is paid for by the Ministry of Education.

Please be aware of the building work and safety areas of access during the re-roof, follow the signage and be aware that the main administration door is the only access to the office at present.

The new changing sheds for the pool are almost finished and we hope to have the pool up and running in time for swimming season. This will also free up the carpark, thank you for your patience in this regard.

NZEI Possible Teacher Strike: The Teachers' and Principals' Union (NZEI), are considering another strike action (rolling strikes around NZ) with the possible date for the Tai Tokerau region set for Tuesday, 13th November. This would mean the school would be closed.

Cool Schools Peer Mediation Programme:

Glenbervie School operates the New Zealand Peace Foundation Cool Schools Programme in classrooms and in the playground. The programme has a Peer Mediation aspect that involves senior students being trained in the process of mediation and conflict resolution. These students are rostered on duty at lunchtimes, alongside teachers, and you will see them by their dayglow vests. The programme aims are:

- To raise awareness of conflict and conflict responses.
- To develop empathy so that individuals listen to each other with understanding.



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- To teach lifelong conflict management skills.
- To develop leadership in giving service to others through peer mediation.
- To empower individuals in making positive choices for building successful relationships.
- To grow respectful, global citizens who value diversity and human rights.

Glenberrie School also encourages students to use the "I" message when trying to resolve any conflict issues in the playground. For example: "Stop it, I don't like it!" This has the effect of personalizing the statement. We also like to resolve any issues students have immediately and would encourage them to speak up and approach the peer mediators in the playground, duty teachers and/or classroom teachers, to manage any issues in the 1st instance.

Parking, Delivery And Pick Up: We are very aware that there are space and safety issues regarding our drop-off and pick-up area. Please remember that it is illegal to park on footpaths and curbs and that you should be driving into the pick-up and drop-off area in the main carpark to ensure student safety.

We ask that you do not park on the footpath area on the roadside by the bus bay. This blocks the view of cars exiting driveways.

The Bus Bay area is for buses only and students should not be arriving and exiting via this gate-way unless being delivered and picked up by bus.



Term 4 is a Sun Smart term and hats are required to be worn by all students. The wonderful sun shade area that we have is

available for students without hats. Our policy to protect everyone from the sun's harmful rays is an important aspect that Glenberrie School actively promotes.
