### 2018 PTA Wrap Up

What a year! The PTA has been able to do so much this year to support the school, teachers and mostly importantly, our kids, the students.

While being on the PTA is often fun and rewarding, the process of raising money for the school is also a serious business, with a lot of effort being put in to making sure there is funding available for the school.

Our school, like most, gets funding from the Ministry of Education to run the operation of the school, but that means there is nothing 'left over' for extras, or sometimes, essentials. The PTA funding fills this gap. While many schools around Whangarei and New Zealand have no PTAs, or ones that struggle to raise

money, I am very proud of our team and the successful fundraising projects we have run this year and the amount collaboratively we've all contributed to the school.

It's important to acknowledge the PTA from previous years who have set aside funding for a 'large project' that has been funded this year – an investment in IT will form part of the long-term IT strategy for the school and will enable the purchase of more IT devices for the school.
