## PTA Term One Update:

Thanks to your support, the PTA has had a great Term One and start to the year. This is what we have been up to:

### Money Raised

Our big fundraiser was the *Colour Run* which raised over \$12,000 in cash and a further \$6,000 in prizes for the students. Feedback from the *Colour Run* was really positive and we know of other schools in Whangarei and Northland looking to do them now too. We have decided to hold the *Colour Run* bi-annually, so the next one will be in 2020.

### Money donated to school

Our PTA purpose is to help the school, teachers and mostly importantly, students. As a PTA we hope to donate approx. \$14,000 to the school this year as a lump sum 'top up' for operational expenses – this covers the likes of visiting school performers, library books, classroom supplies for teachers, sunscreen etc.

We also have requests from teachers throughout the year for additional support and this term we have funded (approximately):

Activities for the children at the schools 125<sup>th</sup> Birthday Celebration \$440

Calculators for seniors \$115

Juniors Bus Trip to Ruakaka \$400

House groups Face Paint \$64

CD Player for the teacher in charge of music \$140.00

We are also in the process of funding a 'tinkers table' for the junior syndicate where kids can dismantle/reassemble broken electronic items. It is a challenging and engaging 'play' option that allows 'tinkering' children to channel their energy and spare time in positive ways - approx \$600.

### Fundraising in Term 2
