Hello all and welcome to the second term of 2018.

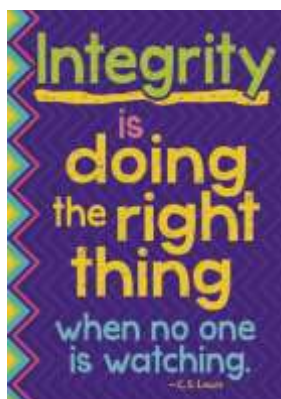
